The DEI is a joint initiative of the American Association of People with Disabilities (AAPD) and the US Business Leadership Network (USBLN). PPL's results are a testament to not only the tangible policies and practices in place to support those with disabilities, but also the supportive culture that celebrates differences and promotes understanding.
